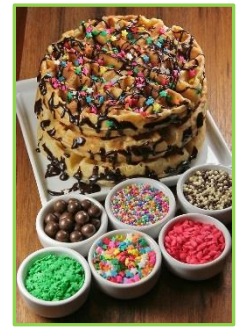

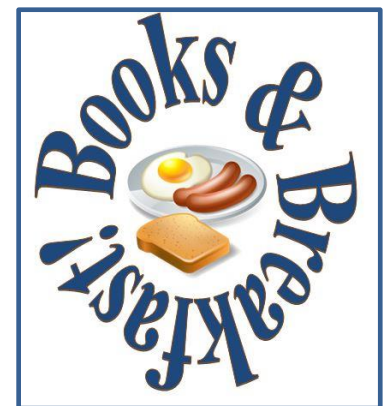

The silent auction will be open for bids the day of the event (Saturday, May 21, 2016) from 6:00pm until closed by the Auction Chairperson at 7:30pm. An announcement will be made before the closing and payment by the winner will be collected on May 21st at the Spring Party.

Each item has been assigned a number and bid sheet listing minimum acceptable bid and raise. Each new bid should be written on the next available line on the bid sheet or on the appropriate line if the bidder chooses to go higher than the next bidding increment. Bids entered after the auction closing announcement will be disallowed.
